We, the Board of Trustees of the Mission Peak Unitarian Universalist Congregation of 2020-2021, commit to work cooperatively together to guide our congregation in furthering its mission and to support, strengthen, and build community within it and within the wider world. We join together to celebrate life and lift up and support one another. We seek to strengthen ourselves and each other as leaders. We are strengthened by our belief that we are all one family, and we are inspired by the seven Unitarian Universalist Principles. - Honor confidentiality when properly requested.
- Encourage each other and provide mutual support.
- Honor each other's worth, abilities, and integrity.
- Honor the commitments for time, energy and actions that we make to this group and its members.

Strengthened by our loving community and common goals, we will strive to:

- Follow the UU Principles in our dealings with each other.
- Support and advance the purpose of the Congregation as stated in our By-Laws, creating and amending policies as needed in our work to actualize our mission.
- Uphold Congregational priorities, including this year's focus on Anti-Racism and Anti-Oppression. In particular we will endeavor to look at our work through an anti-racist / anti-oppressive lens. We will endeavor to center marginalized voices and perspectives.
- Vote on Board decisions with integrity, and then support and implement Board decisions to the best of our abilities.
- Support the individual in achieving the group endeavor.
- We will reflect periodically on our adherence to covenant, particularly if issues come forth, and discuss as needed, and then wholeheartedly re-engage in this mutual agreement.
